Liqiu Village (歷坵村) is located in Jinfeng Township of Taitung County. This is a small, quiet place in which the residents are mostly from the Paiwan and Rukai tribes. Due to its somewhat isolated location, indigenous cultural preservation has been a priority here and during important ceremonies, many cultural elements can be seen. These include a traditional bamboo frame swing and wood carved divination boxes used by the shamans. In past times, these boxes contained the items needed to carry out divination rites before a hunt, as well as healing and other rites... Read more
