
Me model which is tailored for the professional development of educators, in turn facilitating change in their students for holistic development.

To help students prepare for future opportunities to study abroad, Junyi Experimental High School has focused on an English learning environment and proactively assisting and encouraging students to take the relevant international English examinations such as the TOEFL, IELTS, TOEIC and TOEIC BRIDGE. On 19 and 21 October, the school held the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT) for the first time, according to the standardized senior high school assessment set by the College Board of the United States. The format is similar to the SAT, excluding essay writing. 19 students took part in this test that took more than four hours, proving to be a good practice for the SAT.

Student-focused events

This month, a series of Hour of Code™ in Taiwan events were hosted at the New Taipei City′ s English Wonderland English Camp. At the scheme initiated by Arno Shih of Longpu Elementary and the city government open to the fifth-year students at public schools, ACF brings together volunteer IT students from National Taiwan University (NTU) on service learning to create experiential games for elementary schools in the Sanxia, Yingge and Shulin areas of which at the end of the year, NTU students will take these games to the schools in 17 runs. ACF works with Junyi Academy and the Education Department in New Taipei City to promote campus education and teacher training programs online, letting teachers from 28 schools in New Taipei City experience the Hour of Code.
